

# Sacred Love

**Question:** In the distant past, was „Sacred love,, between man and woman also physical or not?

**Answer:** Sacred Love on a physical level is manifested in equality between man and woman in everyday life, and Love on spiritual level means two soul mates that resonate on all other levels and dimensions and within these dimensions they can fully live their Love in material life and thus it becomes physical.

The sacred Love does not take a place, can not happen between two men or two women, it is another type of Love.

Only a couple can live the Sacred Love because there is that Unity and the harmony between man and woman.

But the human being also has a natural desire for sexual fulfilment because it is a physical needs and it is the natural need of every human being.

It is normal for a human being to desire the opposite sex. Many people, however, only experience love on physical level, mostly men, but it is only one-night stand, and it is just the need to get rid off that energy.

Sacred Love is exceptional today. It happens when two - a man and a woman- love each other - really love each other fervently, and they can make it stay.

**Sacred Love is when the lovers are unconditionally devoted to each other and they accept each other in their Love.**

When a woman or a man feel the Love of a partner then they blend in with each other and when the relationship ends or is disrupted the sacredness is no longer there.

**In the distant past, the partners worshipped the sacred love, they also worshipped each other, the partner was sacred. The respect and trust between them remained. This respect and trust for that partner remained, it did not go away and that is why the Sacred Love also remained among them.**

They were also in tune with Mother Earth, with the Cosmic Principles, and consciously aligned with Mother Earth, and therefore they were able to maintain Sacred Love throughout their lives.

Now your society is not doing it and therefore those relationships are damaged and end.

A culture or society that works on the principle of the Cosmic Laws, and that is balanced, creates Sacred Love among the inhabitants naturally.

Part of the life of those people are the Cosmic Laws. They live them, and those cosmic laws work in society and the sacred love happens naturally.

It is normal because everyone lives there in harmony and unity, and therefore Sacred Love is part of it because they are all EQUAL to each other and to all beings and with everything they come in contact with, with water, with nature, even with its elements.

And such a life is PARADISE.

PARADISE, is not a fancy garden with trees where it is forbidden to eat any fruit as it is written in the Bible. They lived in nature and in harmony with nature, and all Knowledge was part of them and therefore nothing was forbidden in those gardens. Nothing was prohibited or banned.

This is a violation of the Equality and a disgrace of Sacred Love, and thus the PARADISE ended. Throughout history that the woman was presented as inferior because she supposed to be the cause of the evil and the sinner.

**The sacred love between man and woman meant that they loved each other in Sacred Love, respecting each other fully, and thus did not limit each other.**

Each of them could do what was essential to him, and the other supported him. There was no jealousy here, for they knew that everyone was thinking about the benefit of each other, and thus they acted.

There was no selfishness. While they did what they thought was right for themselves, they did not limit the others, they did not create expectations and desires.

There was no: „I want you to do it for me,,.

There was Love, Appreciation, Trust and Respect.

There was respect between two equal beings and each of them had the right to choose freely. They did not limit each other.

In Sacred Love you do what is the best for the other because YOU choose freely to do so, YOU want to do it and not because you have to or it is expected from you or because the partner wants it.

**In that mutual Love, Appreciation, Trust and Respect they made decisions in favor of each other and in favor of themselves.**

**So it was a decision in favor of the partner's well-being.**

But even then, it could happen that those couples were alienated and separated if they lost, even just one of these attributes of Love, Appreciation, Trust and Respect, because then all of them gradually disappeared.

If the ego of one of them prevailed, the unconditionality of Sacred Love was lost and the self-interest began to prevail, and the couples then separated.

**All developed civilizations and cultures fell apart due to power control and wanting more, thus EQUALITY has been lost, and so everything in the culture has gradually mutated and Love, Appreciation, Trust and Respect, have been lost among all people.**

**For every human being, there is a natural desire to experience Sacred Love. And this is because, through Sacred Love, a new LIFE is born and renewed on Mother Earth in Unity.**

And that memory of Sacred Love is deeply inscribed on your soul, and therefore other forms of Love will not replace it.

Sacred Love is strong in partnership, you subconsciously desire to experience it, and if you do not find it in your life, it is disappointing and this creates sadness and pain in your life.

**Question: Why is there such an imbalance in the relationship between man and woman that one of them limits the other's freedom. Mostly men do this to women, but is it the other way around as well?**

**Answer:** It happens when that human being needs to have someone to fill that empty space in him/herself.

There is still no equality of all beings in your society, you live in a society where man is superior to woman. When entering into marriage, you make promises in which a woman promises obedience to a man, and based on these promises, a woman becomes as if his property. She promises loyalty to him in good and in bad times. Afterwards he claims her subordination and makes decisions on her behalf.

**If the other human being, in spite of everything, wants to remain in that relationship, then it is important that she realizes that She will NOT CHANGE that other human being.**

**Then she needs to learn to protect herself.  
It is important for her to learn not to be afraid.  
It's about asking and skeaping up for yourself.  
Stand up for yourself.  
What is not Love is fear.**

**If she doesn't say anything, she doesn't ask for anything, so she lets the other human being decide for her.**

SHE has to choose i.e. she has to decide what is important to her and what is that she can give up and what she cannot and how her life would look like in each situation. Can she live life like this, would she like it? Would it fullfil her? How would she react to such life?

In making this decision, it is important not to look at what someone says, because it is not important, people get used to it and accept the change over time. The most important in this decision-making is the HUMAN BEING ITSELF and she should act accordingly, according to nothing and no one else but her.
